Notes on Today's Music:

†HYMN 824

The **Opening Voluntary** is based on the hymn tune ST. GEORGE'S WINDSOR by George J. Elvey, an English organist and composer. The tune name commemorates the royal chapel where Elvey was organist for 47 years.

The text for NUN DANKET ALLE GOTT was written by Martin Rinkart, a German Lutheran clergy and hymnist, who intended the first two verses as a family table prayer during the Thirty Year's War. The tune was composed by Johann Crüger, a German composer, editor, and teacher.

The **Musical Offering** is a setting of the text by Annie Hawks, an American poet and gospel hymnist who wrote a number of hymns with her pastor, Robert Lowry (1826-1899) an American poet and gospel music composer. The setting is by John Ness Beck (1930-1987), a composer, conductor, and arranger of choral music of international renown.

LAND OF REST is an American folk tune with roots in the ballads of northern England and Scotland. It was known throughout the Appalachians; a shape-note version of the tune was published in The Sacred Harp (1844) as the setting for the anonymous text "O land of rest! for thee I sigh," from which the tune derives it's name.

The music and text for There Is a Place of Quiet Rest were written by Cleland Boyd McAfee, American theologian, Presbyterian minister and hymn writer. Written in response to the death of two young nieces, it distills personal grief into the shared assurances of faith.

The **Benediction in Music** is a setting of the hymn tune ST. AGNES composed by John Bacchus Dykes, an English clergyman and hymnwriter, including "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty" and "Eternal Father, Strong to Save." The text a translation of a 12th century Latin hymn. The setting is by Gerald Near, a noted American composer of choral and organ works.
