OFFERTORY

The Offertory is another chorale setting from Bach's *Orgelbüchlein*, containing 46 chorale preludes his original manuscript sketched out a plan for 164 settings of chorale tunes sung during the Church year, so that each part of the year was represented. All but three of the 46 were composed between 1708 and 1717 when Bach served as organist to the ducal court in Weimar.

HYMN 817

The text is by Henry Alford an English churchman, theologian, textual critic, scholar, poet, hymnodist, and writer. The tune name is drawn from a stream in Pennsylvania, where the Dunlap's Creek Presbyterian Church was founded in 1774, becoming the first Presbyterian church to be established west of the Allegheny Mountains.
