MUSICAL OFFERING

The Musical Offering is an adaptation by Douglas Wagner (b.1952) of a three-part round composed by Luigi Cherubini (1740-1842). Cherubini was an Italian composer whose most significant compositions are operas and sacred music. Wagner is an internationally recognized composer and arranger with more than 2,400 titles published including original works and arrangements for choir (church and school), concert band, orchestra, handbell ensemble, organ, piano, instrumental solo and voice. Over fourteen million copies of his music have been sold to date.
