OFFERTORY

Composed by Louis-Nicolas Clérambault (1676-1749), a French musician, best known as an organist and composer who spent his life in Paris. He composed a large number of religious choral pieces and instrumental works which included a book of organ pieces in two suites (1710) which seemed destined to begin a cycle of pieces in all keys but he never completed the cycle. This *Duo* is from that collection.
