AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Following the reunion of the northern and southern Presbyterian denominations in 1983, the church sought to make a statement of faith to be endorsed by the new denomination. This was desirable for both its integrity and identity. Adopted in 1990, The Brief Statement of Faith confesses enduring Reformed beliefs and invites readers to explore more fully their rich meanings. The portion used today emphasizes the discerning of God's Spirit in scripture, preaching, sacraments, church order, and the ministries of the church.
