Notes on Today's Music

The **Opening Voluntary** and **Benediction in Music** were composed by Hermann Schröder (1904 –1984), a German composer and a Catholic church musician. His main sphere of activity as composer, conductor and organist were supplemental to his work as a professor of choral conducting, counterpoint, and composition. He served at Rheinische Musikschule in Cologne, Cologne Musikhochschule, Bonn University and University of Cologne. Schroeder is one of the most important German composers of the 20th century for organ. His music combines elements of the Middle Ages with 20th century polyphony.

The **Musical Offering** is based on John 14:1-14 as set by Mary McDonald (b. 1956), an American composer, arranger, producer, pianist, and organist. She is well-known in sacred music with a career that spans over forty years. Her music appears in the catalogs of every major publisher of church music. More than 1200 compositions through anthems, seasonal musicals and keyboard collections testify to her significant contribution to church music.
