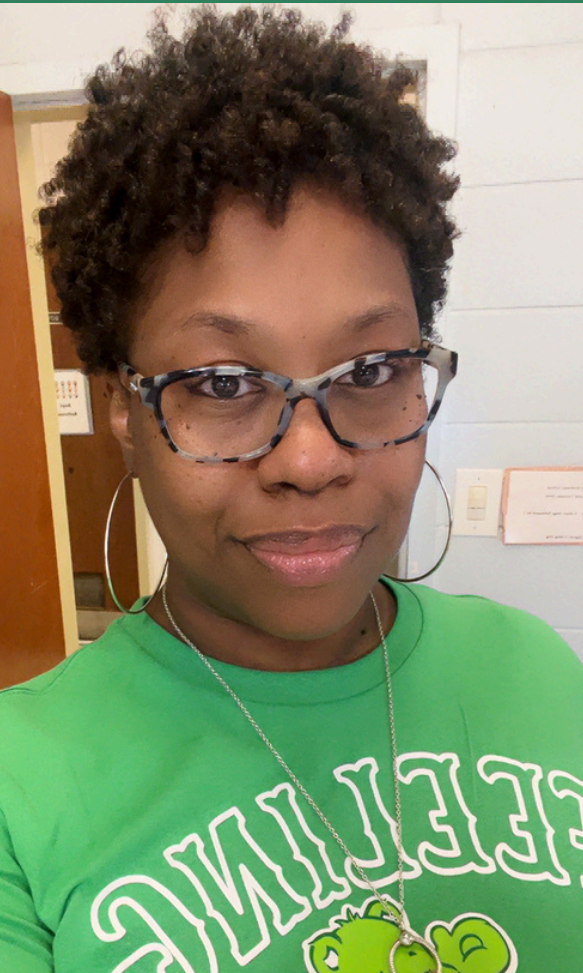

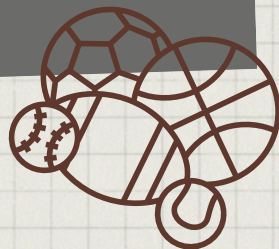
ABOUT ME

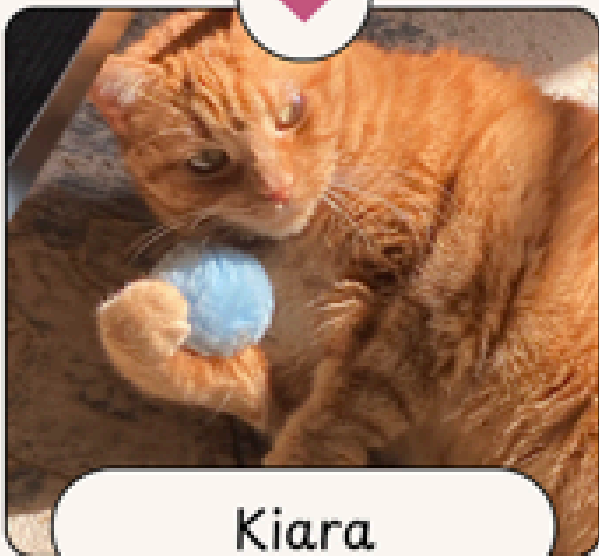


ABOUT ME

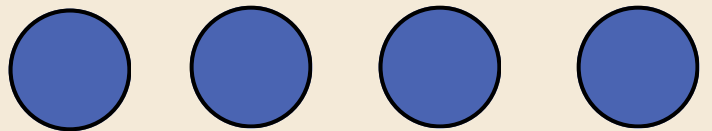
